

**THE PORT ARTHUR HEALTH DEPARTMENT REPORTS COVID-19 RELATED DEATHS FOR PORT ARTHUR, GROVES AND PORT NECHES**

**October 13, 2021**

It is with great sadness that the City of Port Arthur Health Department is reporting COVID-19 related deaths for residents in Port Arthur, Groves and Port Neches. The resident of Port Arthur was a Hispanic Male between the age range of 30-35.

The resident of Groves was a White Male between the age range of 75-80, and the Port Neches resident was a White Female between the age range of 60-65. It has **not** been determined whether the deceased had underlying health conditions. From the onset of the Pandemic, there have been a total of Ninety-Five (95) COVID related deaths for Port Arthur, Twenty-Eight (28) for Groves and Twenty (20) for Port Neches.
