Any Jefferson, Hardin, Orange, Liberty or Chambers County veteran is eligible to receive individualized legal advice from a volunteer attorney in a variety of law areas including:

**Divorce or Custody • Child Support • Bankruptcy • Consumer Issues  
Wills Estate Planning • Landlord/Tenant • Probate • Guardianship  
Housing • Foreclosure • Social Security/SSI  
Other Legal Issues May Apply**

Those who need continued legal representation and who qualify for legal aid may be assigned a pro bono attorney to handle their case. *Financial Guidelines apply for free legal representation.*
