

Consolidated Strategy and Plan Summary for 2019

Notice is hereby given that the City of Port Arthur is making available for examination and comment a draft of its five-year Consolidated Strategy and Plan Submission for the years 2019 - 2023. The Consolidated Strategy and Annual Plan Submission will replace all current Community Planning and Development (CPD) planning and application requirements with a single submission. This Plan will satisfy the minimum statutory requirement for four CPD formula programs: Community Development Block Grant, HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), Emergency Shelter Grants (ESG), Comprehensive Housing Affordability Strategy (CHAS) and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA). A draft of the Plan is available for review at the following location beginning May 10, 2019 through June 10, 2019 from the hours of 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.
