The City of Port Arthur Health Department and Jefferson County Health Department are releasing updates for COVID-19 positive individuals in South and a portion of North Jefferson County.

The situation is fluid as the health departments are receiving results from the testing sites, the hospitals and other private labs. The data above reflects current reports as of May 15, 2020.

If you are experiencing any of the following symptoms:

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills
- Repeated Shaking
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell
- You are concerned you have come in close contact with a confirmed COVID-19 patient or have a history of travel from affected geographic areas within 14 days of symptom onset.
