

NOTICE FROM THE PORT ARTHUR HEALTH DEPARTMENT
THE PORT ARTHUR HEALTH DEPARTMENT REPORTS COVID-19 RELATED
DEATHS FOR PORT ARTHUR

February 23, 2021

It is with great sadness that the City of Port Arthur Health Department is reporting COVID-19 related deaths for Port Arthur. The individuals include a Hispanic Female between the age ranges of 70-75, a Hispanic Male between 85-90, and two White Males between 65-70 and 70-75. It has been determined these individuals had underlying health conditions. The Health Department has reported sixty-six (66) COVID-19 related deaths for Port Arthur since the beginning of this pandemic.

We emphasize again that COVID-19 is a very serious disease. While 80% of individuals who contract COVID-19 will have mild to moderate symptoms and fully recover, they may spread the disease to people who are at high risk. The elderly and people with underlying health conditions or weakened immune systems are at a much higher risk for developing serious complications from COVID-19. We strongly advise at-risk individuals to minimize contact with others who are ill, practice social distancing, and wear a mask when in public.
